This notice is issued pursuant to Article 8 of the Environmental Conservation Law (State Environmental Quality Review Act) and the implementing regulations therefor at 6 NYCRR Part 617.

A Draft Environmental Impact Statement (DEIS) has been completed and accepted for the proposed action described below. A public hearing on the DEIS will be held on July 12, 2017, at 7:30 p.m. at Village Hall, One Shelter Rock Road, North Hills, New York 11576, at which time verbal and written comments will be accepted. Written comments on the DEIS will continue to be accepted at the offices of the lead agency for 10 days after the close of the public hearing, or until such later date as may be established by the lead agency.

Classification:** Type I

Description of Action: The proposed action consists of a 46-lot residential subdivision of a 30.43±-acre parcel of land situated on the west side of Searingtown Road, identified on the Nassau County Land & Tax Map as Section 3 – Block 162 – Lot 822. The proposed action would result in the creation of 46 single-family residential building lots and one common lot containing a clubhouse and a parking area within a gated residential community. Associated improvements would include paved roadways, a gatehouse, stormwater management facilities and other appurtenances. Access to the subdivision would be provided from Searingtown Road at the approximate location of the existing site driveway. The parcel currently contains accessory structures and infrastructure related to the former, demolished St. Ignatius Jesuit Retreat Center, including a reflecting pool, stone labyrinth, a small shed, a single-story building, an asphalt driveway, three small parking lots, and a sanitary system, all of which are proposed to be removed. An existing stormwater recharge basin utilized by a neighboring residential development will be retained.
