Subject: ADJOURNED HEARING Case No. 20-04za. Application of Scott Tirone, 75 Albertson Avenue, Albertson, New York, as agent for Howard Beige, 8 Bradford Road, North Hills, New York, to construct a one story addition, covered outdoor kitchen, and patio with sitting walls, which construction requires a permit pursuant to Village Code §215-33(A) to permit the sitting walls, and variances of the following Village Code provisions: (a) Village Code §215-11(D)(6), in that the dwelling will be set back 21.67 feet from the rear property line, where a minimum of 50 feet is required; and (b) Village Code §215-25(E)(5)(c), in that the barbeque is 11.75 feet wide and in a required rear yard setback area, where no barbeque may exceed 6 feet in width or be located in a required yard setback. Premises are designated as Section 3, Block 205, Lot 24 on the Nassau County Land and Tax Map.

The application is a Type II action under the State Environmental Quality Review Act (SEQRA), which requires no environmental review.

Any person having a disability which would inhibit attendance at or participation in the hearing should notify the Village Administrator at least three business days prior to the hearing, so that reasonable efforts may be made to facilitate such attendance and participation.

All relevant documents may be inspected at the office of the Village Administrator, One Shelter Rock Road, North Hills, New York, during regular business hours.
