PSEG of Long Island has a special program for Critical Care. If you qualify you must contact PSEG directly pursuant to the following message from PSEG Long Island:

In unforeseen circumstances or severe weather, electrical outages may occur. If this should occur, every effort will be made to restore your electricity as soon as possible.

**Critical Care does not guarantee priority restoration of service and there may be certain instances when timely restoration is difficult.**

It is of the utmost importance that you develop a plan now because it is your responsibility to ensure that medical needs are addressed in the event of a power outage.

If you or a member of your family rely on life-support equipment, filing a medical certificate from your doctor or local Board of Health with us is important

1. File a medical certificate with us from a doctor or the local Board of Health
2. We can then mark your account and tag your meter as “**Critical Care**”
3. When we anticipate a severe storm, we will call you so that you can make advanced preparations.

The following are devices that meet the medical criteria for life-support equipment:

Apnea Monitor  
Curraise Respirator  
Positive Pressure Respirator  
Suction Machine  
IV Feeding Machine  
Tank Type Respirator  
Respirator/Ventilator  
Hemodialysis Machine  
Rocking Bed Respirator  
Oxygen Concentrator  
IV Medical Infusion Machine

Additional devices may qualify as life-support equipment if certified by a physician.
